### AT THE LANDFILL SITE

#### WE RECYCLE

- **Electronics** - Display Monitors & Televisions, Desktop Computers, Portable Computers, Computer Accessories (Keyboard, Mouse etc.), Printers, Copiers & Multifunction Devices, Telephone & Answering Machines, Cellular Devices & Pagers, Home Theatre & Stereo equipment, Aftermarket Vehicle Audio & Video Devices, Home or Portable Image & Audio Devices. Please note that Microwaves belong with the Appliances.
- **Tires** - Tires on rims will not be accepted.
- **Steel** – All types of steel are accepted.
- **Appliances** – All appliances are accepted. Please place fridges & freezers in a normal standing position and latching or locking doors must be removed.
- **Aluminum**– Please help by making sure deposited items are made from aluminum. Aluminum is not magnetic. If you are unsure please ask the Attendant for help.
- **Batteries & Cellphones** – Collection Kits are available at the Municipal Office, Lester B. Smith Community Centre, Madawaska Complex, Whitney and Madawaska Library and both Landfill Sites.

#### WE DIVERT

**Clean Wood** - Only brush, unpainted or untreated wood may be deposited in the brush area.

**Reuse** – Items suitable for reuse may be placed in the Reuse Area.

#### WE REDUCE

**Shredding** – Most waste that is not Hazardous, Household, Clean Wood, Reusable or Recyclable may be deposited in the Shredding Pile. *(No food)*

**Furniture** – Furniture & mattresses may be deposited in the Furniture Pile.

*Please see the Landfill Site Attendant prior to disposing material to ensure proper location for disposal.*

#### Transporting Waste

**Residents are required to secure and cover loads to avoid debris from falling off onto municipal roads and highways.**

### HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION AREAS:

- **TUESDAY** - Old 127, Hwy. 127 from the Old 127 south to the Sabine Ward including McGuey Rd, McKenzie Lake Rd area, returning north on Hwy 127 to Old 127.
- **WEDNESDAY** – The Village of Madawaska, Hwy 60 to the eastern boundary of the Township including Spectacle Lake Rd, Major Lake Rd & McCauley Lake Rd, Hwy 523 to the southern boundary of the Township. From 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm the waste collection truck will be located at the Aylen Lake Boat Launch, 1706 Aylen Lake Rd. as long as the weather permits then it will move to the corner of Aylen Lake Rd. and North Aylen Lake Rd.
- **THURSDAY** - Hwy. 60 from the Village of Madawaska's western boundary to Hwy 127, south on Hwy 127 to Old 127/Hwy 127, returning north on Hwy 127 to Hwy 60, west on Hwy 60 to Whitney then the Village of Whitney including Hwy 60 to the western boundary of the Township, returning east on Hwy 60 to Madawaska.

#### PICKUP TIME AND CONTAINERS

The time of your roadside pick-up could be anytime between 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on your scheduled day. Residents are required to place household waste in approved containers at the roadside on the scheduled day of collection to deter birds and animals from spreading the waste.

#### NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

**Waste deposited anywhere other than landfill sites will be considered illegal dumping and is subject to fines up to \$5,000.00 as per By-Law 14-454.**
