Madawaska Landfill Site Expansion Update

- No further response has been received from Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP). The Works Superintendent circulated a summary of the pre and post landfill site expansion application efforts and the history of the acquisition of the land that began in 2002. Staff to draft a letter to the Minister of MECP and copy MPP John Yakabuski. A draft letter will be brought back to council for review.

NEW BUSINESS:

Waste Diversion

- Works Superintendent updated the committee on the research conducted regarding the diversion of glass, cardboard, plastic and fibre. Ottawa Valley Waste Recovery will not take our waste as the township is not in Renfrew County. Staff will continue to research for a market and look into getting a bin for cans.

Waste Collection Schedule

- R. Shalla requested to have the waste collection schedule changed to pick up in Sabine on Sundays instead of Tuesdays from May until October. Staff provided a verbal outline of the changes to Sunday pick up that would need to occur to implement. Council directed staff to circulate the current schedule to council, and report on the impact and cost implication to changing the schedule, hopefully for implementation July 1, 2019.

- The new signage for the landfill sites will be erected during spring cleanup.
