-Cell Tower Service: Councillor Vermaire stated that the already slow internet speed in the Aylen Lake area has gotten even worse since COVID-19. He used an app for download speeds and checked surrounding areas; Aylen Lake is much slower and has very poor signal strength. Staff will send a complaint letter to Bell Canada regarding poor service throughout the entire township.
