

NEW BUSINESS:

- Reviewed and discussed the circulated documents regarding a free battery and cell phone collection program offered through Call2Recycle Canada Inc. Staff to enroll in the program and place collection kits at all Township facilities. Staff to promote the program to local businesses through the township newsletter.
- Written correspondence circulated from the Whitney Landfill Site Attendant requesting clarifications on commercial tipping fees. Council discussed the tipping fees and the consensus was that the fees will remain as is. Staff to advise the Landfill Site Attendants that property owners, including business owners who dispose their own waste will not be charged tipping fees as described in the Schedule of Fees By-Law 15-490. Tipping fees will be applied when a Contractor is hired to dispose the waste for the land owner.
- The 2016 Work Plan and Budget Summary circulated for Council information.
- Draft letters, prepared by Jp2g Consultant Inc. for both landfill site were circulated in response to the TSS Groundwater review by Ministry of Environment and Climate Change dated March 9, 2016 of the 2014 Annual Monitoring Report. Council to review and forward comments to D. Gatley prior to the next Council meeting.
