## Help with Heating Costs

**A One Time Heating Grant** has been re-introduced for this winter through the District of Nipissing Social Services Administration Board - The Community Homelessness Prevention Initiative (CHPI). Through this program, you may qualify for assistance with heating related costs such as: wood, propane, oil, oil tank replacement and furnace repairs. Homeowners and Renters are eligible to apply. Partial payments for heating related one-time expenses that exceed \$3,000.00 will be considered if documentation can be provided to verify that the balance has been paid. Must meet CHPI eligibility criteria including reason for applying, income level and asset level. Maximum of \$3,000.00. The maximum allowable benefit of up to \$3,000.00 may be accessed in a 24 month period. Grant will be available until March 31, 2016 or until funding has been exhausted. ### Animal Control

**Dog Tags** - Residents of the Township of South Algonquin who own or harbour dogs are required by **BY-LAW #12-430** to purchase a DOG TAG for each animal they are responsible for. Dog Tags purchased are valid for the lifetime of your dog. Tags are available at the Municipal Office for \$10.00. Replacement tags are \$5.00.

**Please be a Considerate and Responsible Dog Owner** and keep dogs on a leash and in control by a competent person when off your property. They are to be deterred from running on the private property of other residents.

**9-1-1 NOW AVAILABLE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH ALGONQUIN****How to use 9-1-1:**

- If at home, dial 9-1-1.
- If at a business or other location, you may need to dial an outside line before dialing 9-1-1.
- If at a pay phone, dial 9-1-1. No payment is required.
- If using a cellular phone, dial 9-1-1 and give the exact location of the emergency, including city or town.
- T.T.Y./Teletypewriter users only: after dialing, press the space bar intermittently until a response is received.
- When your call is answered, the 9-1-1 operator will ask: police, fire or ambulance? Indicate the emergency service you need.

**When to call 9-1-1**

Call 9-1-1 to:

- Stop a crime
- Report a fire
- Save a life
- In any EMERGENCY situation whenever police, fire or ambulance assistance is required IMMEDIATELY.

If you are unsure, call 9-1-1 and the communicator will make the final determination.

**Do not call 9-1-1 to:**

- Report a hydro outage
- Check weather or highway conditions
- Obtain government information
- For directory assistance
- For information about school closing, road conditions, directions, etc.
- For municipal information
